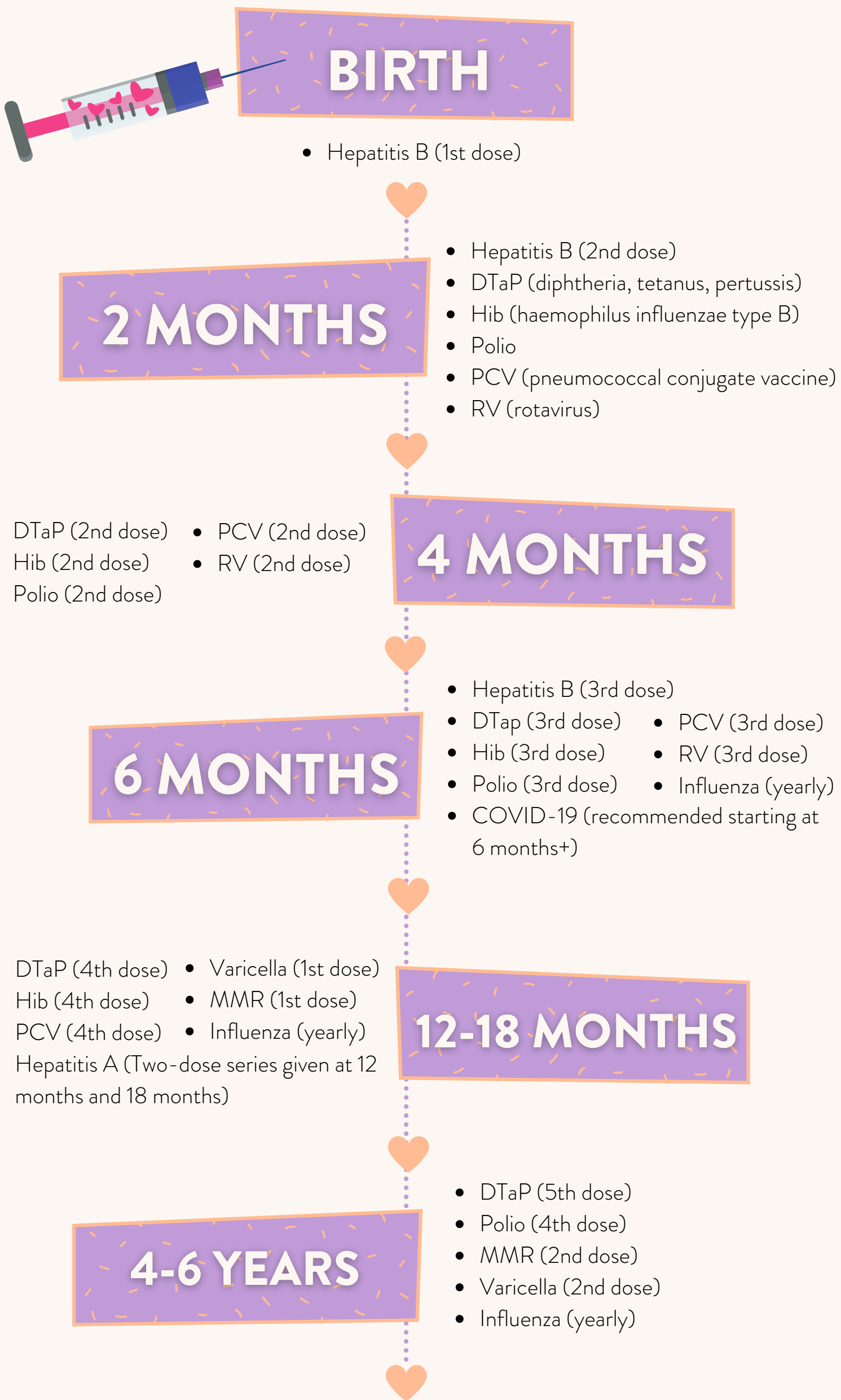


BABY VACCINE RECOMMENDATIONS IN GEORGIA

Routine vaccines are strongly recommended in children between the ages of 0-6 years to prevent serious diseases.



FACTS ABOUT VACCINES

- In order for your child to attend child care or enter school, Georgia requires your child to be up-to-date on all their immunizations.
- Common side effects from vaccinations include mild fever, tenderness at injection site, and fussiness. It is very rare for your child to experience serious side effects.
- While some parents may be concerned about giving their child vaccinations early, the diseases that childhood vaccines are meant to prevent are most likely to occur when your child is very young, so it is important to prevent serious complications.
- Despite much controversy, vaccines do NOT cause autism and researchers have not found any correlation between the two.
